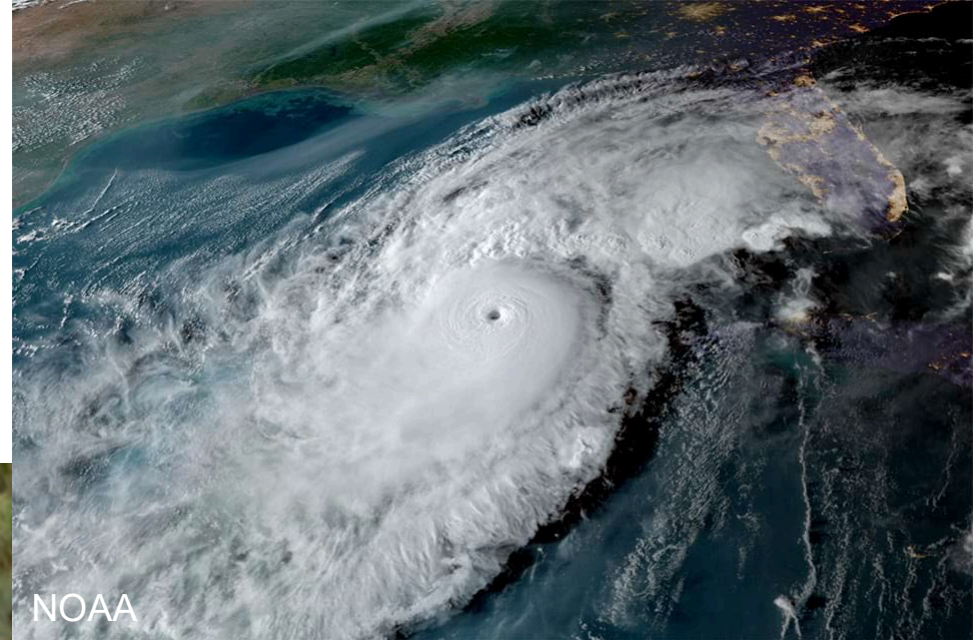

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CS/CS/SB 1954: Statewide Flooding and Sea Level Rise Resilience

GENERAL BILL by Appropriations ; Environment and Natural Resources ; Rodrigues ; (CO-INTRODUCERS) Garcia ; Rodriguez

Statewide Flooding and Sea Level Rise Resilience; Establishing the Resilient Florida Grant Program within the Department of Environmental Protection; requiring the department to complete a comprehensive statewide flood vulnerability and sea level rise data set and assessment by specified dates; requiring the department to develop an annual Statewide Flooding and Sea Level Rise Resilience Plan and submit the plan to the Governor and Legislature by a specified date; requiring the department to implement a scoring system for assessing projects eligible for inclusion in the plan, etc.

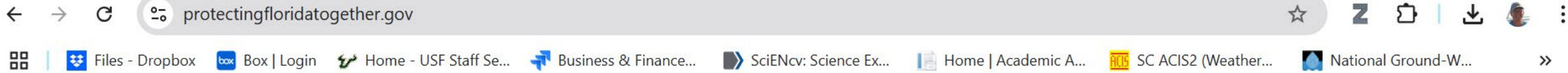
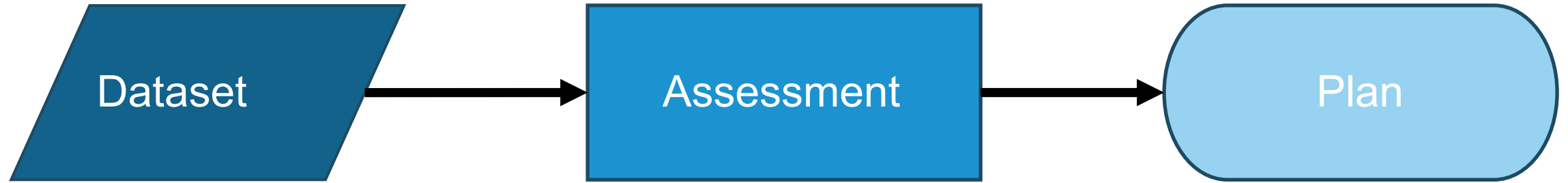

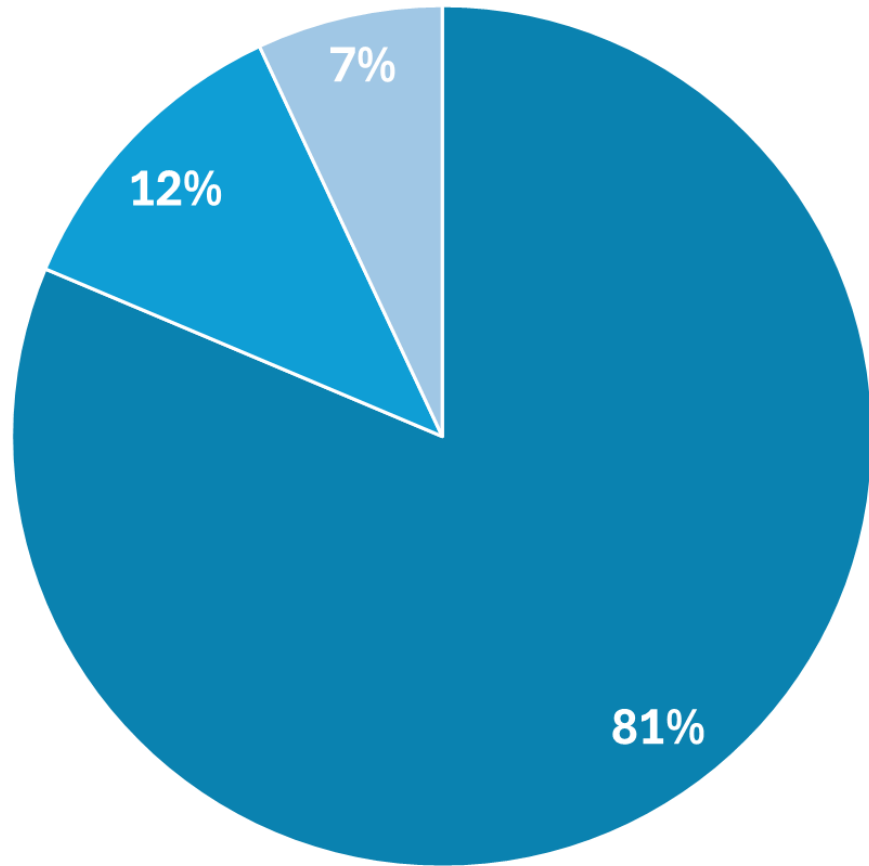
DATASET

- Critical asset dataset (Local Governments)
 - Transportation assets (e.g., ports, airports)
 - Infrastructure assets (e.g., drinking water facilities)
 - Community and emergency facilities (e.g., fire stations, hospitals)
 - Natural, cultural, and historical resources (e.g., shorelines, historical and cultural assets)
- Flood dataset
 - Sea level rise
 - Extreme rainfall
 - Compound flooding





PLANNING GRANTS PROJECT TYPE



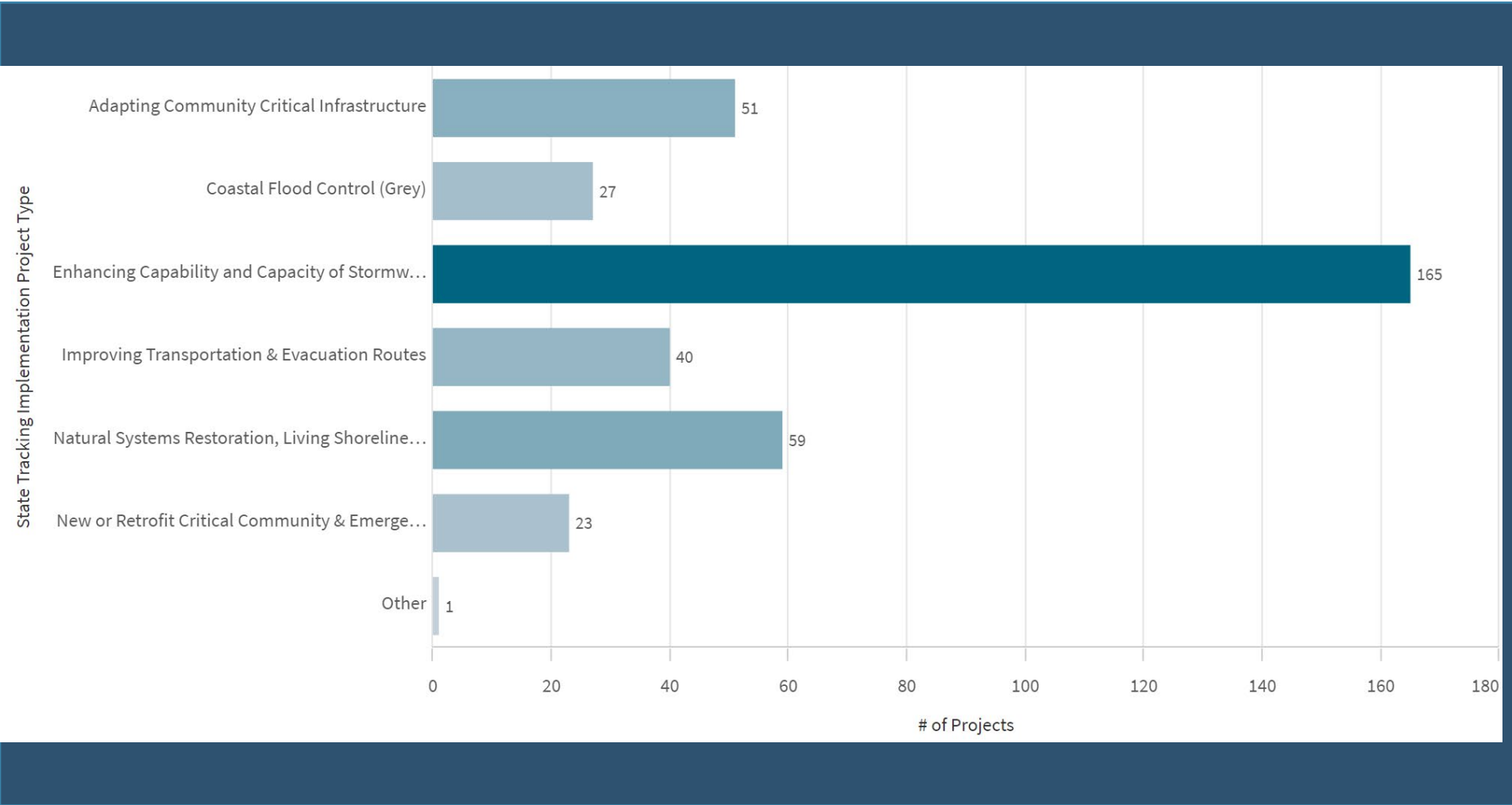
